PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

On May 22, 2020, the Department of Children Youth and Their Families of the City and County of San Francisco issued a notice of intent to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program Solicitation FY 2020. The JAG Program (34 U.S.C. 10151-10158) is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. The CESF Program is authorized by Division B of H.R. 748, Pub. L. No. 116136 (Emergency Appropriations for Coronavirus Health Response and Agency Operations); 28 U.S.C. 530C. The due date for applying for funds under this announcement is May 29, 2020. However, those interested in commenting on this funding opportunity are required to respond by close of business on May 27, 2020.
