PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

On February 18, 2020, the Department of Children Youth and Their Families of the City and County of San Francisco released the <u>FY19/20 Request for Proposals and Qualifications</u>. This RFP and RFQ will provide up to \$3,380,000 annually in funding from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023.

All funding allocations are strategy specific, and the funds provided must be used for the specific program purposes outlined under each strategy. Funding awards are subject to the availability of funds and grant terms. The following chart details all of the strategies that will be included in this RFP and RFQ with their allocations.
