PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

San Francisco, CA – On August 10, 2018, the Department of Children Youth and Their Families of the City and County of San Francisco issued a notice of intent to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY2018 Local Solicitation. The JAG Program (34 U.S.C. 10151-10158) is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions. JAG funds support all components of the criminal justice system, from multijurisdictional drug and gang task forces to crime prevention and domestic violence programs, courts, corrections, treatment and justice information sharing initiatives. The due date for applying for funds under this announcement is August, 22, 2018. However, those interested in commenting on this funding opportunity are required to respond by close of business on August 13, 2018.
